Every Chicago Dixie Marchers / Chicago Dixie Band show features the music of such Jazz and Dixieland luminaries as Louis Armstrong, Bob Crosby, Duke Ellington, Count Basie, Pete Fountain, and countless other Jazz and Dixieland hall of famers. This "Little Big Band" is known as the "Big Little Band" as they average six feet - five inches in height and weigh over 1300 pounds with only five guys!!!
